Monthly School Report
December 2015

1. Visit of Dr. Chiu Chi Shing and the Participants of “Professional Development Programme for Middle Leaders in Schools” organized by the Hong Kong Institute of Education
On 1st December morning, Dr. Chiu Chi Shing and the participants of “Professional Development Programme for Middle Leaders in Schools” which was organized by the Hong Kong Institute of Education visited our school. I introduced our school’s characteristics and the management strategies to them. I also escorted them to have a campus tour.
2. 45th Anniversary Banquet
On 5th December evening, the 45th Anniversary Banquet was held for celebration and reunion. We had 86 tables, a total of 1100 people attending this banquet. Our honourable guests, serving staff, retired and leaving staff, alumni and parents gathered and enjoyed the traditional basin meals.
3. Blood Donation
On 7th December, our school organized a blood donation activity for teachers, staff and students to donate blood to the persons in need. 75 teachers, staff and students donated their blood.
4. Visit from Mainland Secondary School Principals
On 9th December afternoon, 25 school principals who are participants in “The 6th Mainland, Hong Kong and Taiwan Principals’ Forum” visited our school to learn more about the education system in Hong Kong and the characteristics of our school. Ms. Keung Woon Hang and I escorted the guests during the campus tour. The guests invited our school teachers and students to visit their schools for cultural exchange and explored the possibility of further collaboration.
5. Christmas Concert
On 10th December after school, the Music Department organized a concert called “Christmas Concert” in the School Hall. About 280 students and teachers attended the concert.
6. Inter-class Rope-skipping Competition and fund raising programme
On 11th December afternoon, our school organized a popular event - Rope-skipping Competition to raise fund for the Jump Rope for Heart Program (JRFH). Our school has

joined the event for twelve years. The mission of JRFH is to motivate our young generations to develop a healthy lifestyle through exercise, thus reduce the risk of heart disease and stroke. Each class had their team participated in the competition with great effort in practice before the competition.

7. Invitation to talk to Parents of CCC Kei Tsz Primary School

On 11th December evening, I was invited to give a talk to the parents of CCC Kei Tsz Primary School on Secondary School Place Allocation System. About 200 parents attended the talk.

8. Wong Tai Sin Joint Primary School Mathematics Competition

On 12th December, our school organized Wong Tai Sin Joint Primary School Mathematics Competition. 205 students from 23 primary schools participated in this competition. The competition aimed to test participants' reasoning power, problem solving abilities and collaboration skills.

On 13th December, the PTA of our school organized a PTA Picnic. They visited at Repulse Bay Visual Art Museum, the Peak Tower and the PMQ. Participants enjoyed the picnic.

10. Visit to Mother School-Guangzhou XieHe High School

From 18th to 20th December, Ms. Chan Suk Tuen, Extra-Curricular Activities Mistress, with Mr. Cheung Wing Hing led twenty nine students to visit our mother school XieHe High School. They visited the mother school, joined the Exchange Programme "Searching Roots" and had friendly matches with the students in the mother school. They enjoyed the visit.

11. Christmas Celebration and Class Party

On 22nd December, our school organized the Christmas Celebration and class parties. We invited Rev. Chan Wing Fai from Tsz Oi Baptist Church to give a sermon regarding Jesus' salvation. Then, students went back to their classrooms to have parties. Most students enjoyed these two functions.

12. "Heep Woh's Singing Contest"

On 22nd December, Students' Association (SA) organized Heep Woh's Singing Contest, a traditional event in HWC. The event comprised individual and group competitions. Students participated in the event actively.

13. Report from Subject Departments

Mathematics Department

(1) On 7th December, 5 S.6 students participated in a talk on HKDSE Mathematics organized

by Faculty of Education, HKU. Mr. Li WK led the group.

- (2) On 7th December, S.6 HKDSE Mathematics Remedial Class was conducted by Mr. Lee S.F.. 16 students joined the class.
- (3) On 12th December, 4 S.1 students participated in ‘Super 24 Mathematics Competition’ organized by Shun Tak Fraternal Association Seaward Woo College. S.1A Szeto Tak Hei and S.1B Ngan Man Leon successfully entered semi-final and were finally awarded the Second-runner-up.
- (4) On 14th December, Mathematics Society organized “Maths. Fun Day” to arouse S.1 – S.3 students’ interest in Mathematics. Mr. Lee S.F. was the teacher in charge.
- (5) On 15th December, the Mathematics Olympiad Training Course, which consists of 10 lessons in 3 months, was completed. 60 S.1 –S.4 students joined the course with over 90% attendance rate in the course. The participants will be selected to represent our school to join the competitions outside schools. Ms. Chu KM and Chan KY Eric were the teachers in charge.
- (6) On 17th December, the Department organized a Pre-Mock Examination of Mathematics in Paper II (Multiple Choice) for S.6 students so as to provide them with more opportunities to be familiar with various questions types.
- (7) On 19th December, 6 S.3 students participated in Pan-Asia Pacific International Mathematics Invitation Competition organized by Hong Kong Gifted Education Association. S.3D Chan Chak Kwan and Ngan man Cheuk won the First runner-up and S.3D Chan Yin Wai and Chan Chun Ting won the Second runner-up.
- (8) On 16th December, S.6 Mathematics Tutorial Class which consists of 8 lessons was completed. 16 S.6 students joined the course. Mr. Li WK and Ms. Chu KM were the teachers in charge.
- (9) Others
