1. Invitation to talk to Parents of CCC Kei Wa Primary School
On 3rd December morning, I was invited to give a talk to the parents of CCC Kei Wa Primary School on the Secondary School Place Allocation System. About 100 parents attended the talk.

2. Home Coming Day Cum Alumni Association AGM and Basin Meals

15. Report from Subject Departments

Mathematics Department

- (1) The Mathematics Society organized an activity 'Monthly Mathematics Challenge' to arouse students' interest in Mathematics. The winners for December were 6C Ma Chun Hin and 2A Wong Wing Kei.
- (2) On 12th December, the Department organized a Pre-Mock Examination of Mathematics in Paper II (Multiple Choice) for S.6 students so as to provide them with more opportunities to be familiar with various questions types.
- (3) On 15th December, S.4 Mathematics Remedial Class with 9 lessons were completed by Mr. Lee S.F.. 26 students joined the class.
- (4) On 19th December, S.5 Mathematics Remedial Class with 7 lessons were completed by Mr. Lee S.F.. 18 students joined the class.
- (5) On 19th December, the Mathematics Olympiad Training Course, which consists of 8 lessons in 3 months, was completed. 47 S.1 –S.3 students joined the course with over 80% attendance rate. The participants will be selected to represent our school to join the competitions outside schools. Ms. Chu KM was the teachers in charge.
- (6) On 10th December, 2 S.2 students participated in Pan-Asia Pacific International Mathematics Invitation Competition organized by Hong Kong Gifted Education Association. S.3A So Yee Lam won the First runner-up and S.2A Wong Sze Long and Ngan Man Leong won the Second runner-up.
- (7) On 1st December, S.5E Chan Lai Ying, Chan Tsun Kit and Siu King San successfully completed the Gifted Course organized by the Mathematics Department of the University of Hong Kong and were finally awarded the Certificate of Attainment.
