1. Farewell to Graduates Assembly

The students joined 3 lessons including Physical Education, Integrated Science and Music.

Mathematics Department

- (1) The Mathematics Society organized an activity ‘Monthly Mathematics Challenge’ to arouse students’ interest in Mathematics. 46 students participated in the activity. The winners for February were 5A Chan Lai Yuen and 3A Choy Man Pan.
- (2) S.1-3 Mathematics teachers discussed the arrangement of tutorial classes for students in need in junior forms. 29 S.1 students, 14 S.2 students and 11 S.3 students were recruited. The tutorial classes for S.1-3 will be held every Tuesday to Thursday in March.
- (3) On 11th February, 5 S.3 students were nominated to participate in the 19th Hong Kong Youth Mathematical Achievers Selection Contest organized by Po Leung Kuk and Hong Kong Association for Science and Mathematics Education, and sponsored by Home Affairs Department, HKSAR. Mr. Li WK led the team.
- (4) On 18th February, 15 S.1-3 students were nominated to participate in the 16th Pui Ching Invitation Mathematics Competition organized by Pui Ching Middle School and 6 S.4 students participated in Hong Kong Mathematics Olympiad (HKMO) organized by EDB, HKSAR. Ms. Chu Ka Man and Alumnus Mr. Wong Tsz Yeung led the team respectively.
- (5) Our Department co-worked with English Department in the LAC (Language Across Curriculum) Project and finished the project in February. On 20th February, English Teachers were invited to observe S.1 Mathematics lessons.
- (6) Our school exchanged our Mock Examination papers with Ying Wa Girls’ School and Shatin Pui Ying College to broaden our students’ exposure to various styles of questions.
- (7) In order to enhance learning in Module 2, S.4 students taking M2 as elective were given an additional exercise.
- (8) The Mathematics Society published a magazine called “Mathgazine” to arouse students’ interest in Mathematics. The issue of this magazine was about problem solving, overview of DSE syllabus and some interesting stories.

Chemistry Department (Science KLA)
