1. Congratulations to our students for winning the Championship of the Hong Kong Odyssey of Mind Competition 2017  
On 1<sup>st</sup> April, our students 3A Huen Cho Ki, Sung Wai Man, 3B Tang Chi Fung, 3C Chu Chun Hin, 3D Ip Pak Yin, Kwok Ling Yan and Yeung Lok To participated in the Hong Kong Odyssey of Mind Competition of World Odyssey of Mind Hong Kong Regional Selection organized by the Hong Kong Odyssey of Mind Association. There were over 36 schools participating in the competition. Participants were required to fulfill the task designed to solve a given challenge set on a table. Moreover, students enjoyed working in teams with fun and learning during the process of the competition. Being the Champion of the Hong Kong Competition, our student team is invited to join the Odyssey of the Mind World Finals at Michigan State University.
