**Monthly School Report**  
**December 2017**

1. Gospel Week

From 27<sup>th</sup> November to 1<sup>st</sup> December, the Religious Education Committee organized a Gospel Week to arouse students' interest in the gospel. Christian activities such as an Evangelistic Meeting, Christians Sharing Session, Hymn and Testimony Sharing, Book Fair and Lunch Time Hymn Broadcasting were held. On 1<sup>st</sup> December, we invited Rev. Leung Wing Sin to give a sermon regarding Jesus' salvation.

2. Invitation to talk to Parents of CCC Kei Wa Primary School

On the morning of 2<sup>nd</sup> December, I was invited to give a talk to the parents of CCC Kei Wa Primary School about the Secondary School Place Allocation System. Approximately a hundred parents attended the talk.

3. Home Coming Day Cum Alumni Association AGM and Basin Meals

On the evening of 2<sup>nd</sup> December, the Homecoming Day cum Alumni Association AGM was held. Alumni were warmly welcomed. They joined the AGM of the Alumni Association. Furthermore, the Alumni Association arranged 15 tables of Buffet to have a reunion with the alumni, the former and current teachers.

4. Third Staff Meeting

On 6<sup>th</sup> December, I chaired the 3<sup>rd</sup> Staff Meeting. We discussed issues including the Transversal Skills, wearing jackets in extreme cold weather, enhancing usage of e-Notices of Parents App., Use of SAM Grant - installation of IP Camera and installation of the Infrared Thermal Imaging Camera and other school routines.

5. CCC Joint Schools Information Day

On 8<sup>th</sup> December, our school joined the CCC Joint Schools Information Day organized by CCC Headquarters. The aim of the event was to introduce all CCC Secondary Schools to parents of CCC primary schools and other parents as well. There were booths set up for all CCC Secondary Schools. Participants learned more details about the CCC schools at the event. In the morning, an Opening Ceremony was launched to kick off the event. Dr. Choi Yuk Lin, JP, the Under-Secretary for Education, was invited to be the honourable guest. At noon, I was also invited to be one of the speakers of the Parents' Talk to share my views on Interviewing Skills for the Interview of the S.1 Discretionary Place Allocation.

On the morning 9<sup>th</sup> December, Mr. Wong Chun Tat, the Assistant Principal, and I were invited to give a talk to the students and the parents of Canossa Primary School on the Secondary School Place Allocation System. Approximately 200 students and parents attended the talk.
9. PTA Picnic  
On 10<sup>th</sup> December, the PTA of our school organized a PTA Picnic. They visited the west part of New Territories, including Lau Fau Shan and Kam Tin. Participants enjoyed the picnic.
10. Christmas Concert  
After school on 14<sup>th</sup> December, the Music Department organized a "Christmas Concert" in the School Hall. Approximately 280 students and teachers attended the concert.
11. Inter-class Rope-skipping Competition and fund raising programme  
On the afternoon of 15<sup>th</sup> December, our school organized a popular event - Rope-skipping Competition - to raise funds for the Jump Rope for Heart Program (JRFH). Our school has held the event for fifteen years. The mission of JRFH is to motivate our young generations to develop a healthy lifestyle through exercise, thus reducing the risk of heart disease and stroke. Each class had their team participate in the competition and made a great effort practicing beforehand.
12. 2017 Shenzhen, Hong Kong and Macau Secondary School Students' Writing Competition  
On the afternoon of 16<sup>th</sup> December, a prize-giving ceremony of the "2017 Shenzhen, Hong Kong and Macau Secondary School Students' Writing Competition" was held at our school to present the awards. Dr. Choi Yuk Lin, JP, the Under-Secretary for Education, was invited to be the honourable guest.

### 13. Christmas Celebration and Class Party

On 22<sup>nd</sup> December, our school organized the Christmas Celebration and class parties. We invited Ms. Lee Tin Man to give a sermon regarding Jesus' salvation. After this, students went back to their classrooms to have parties. Students enjoyed these two functions.

### 14. "Heep Woh's Singing Contest"

On 22<sup>nd</sup> December, Students' Association (SA) organized Heep Woh's Singing Contest, a traditional event in HWC. The event comprised individual and group competitions. Students participated in the event actively.

### 15. Visit to Malaysia Union School

From 27<sup>th</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> December, Mr. Fung Wah Sing (the Vice-Principal), Mr. Wong Chun Tat (the Assistant Principal) and I visited Malaysia Union School to learn about the Malaysian Education System and establish collaboration in the near future.

### 16. Report from Subject Departments

#### **Mathematics Department**

- (1) The Mathematics Society organized an activity 'Monthly Mathematics Challenge' to arouse students' interest in Mathematics. The winners for December were Chan Chun Ting (5D) and Lau Siu Yau (2B).
- (2) On 5<sup>th</sup> December, the Department organized a Pre-Mock Examination of Mathematics in Paper II (Multiple Choice) for S.6 students so as to provide them with more opportunities to be familiar with various questions types.
- (3) On 7<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> December, S.4 Mathematics Remedial Class Tutorials were held by Mr. Lee S.F. and alumnus Mr. Au Chi Ho.  
On 4<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> December, S.5 Mathematics Remedial Class Tutorials were held by Mr. Lee S.F. and Mr. Li W.K..  
On 14<sup>th</sup> December, S.6 Mathematics Elite, Give Me Five and Remedial Class Tutorials were held by Mr. Li W.K., Mr. Lee S.F. and Mr. Wong C.T., the Assistant Principal.
- (4) On 19<sup>th</sup> December, the Mathematics Olympiad Training Course was completed. Fifty two S.1 –S.4 students joined the course with over 80% attendance rate. The participants will be selected to represent our school to join the competitions outside schools. Ms. Chu KM was the teacher in charge.
- (5) On 7<sup>th</sup> December, a STEM activity "The Flying Carp" was jointly organized by the Mathematics Society and the Science Society. Thirty students joined the activity.
- (6) Results of External Competition:
  - On 9<sup>th</sup> December, Pang Bo Yee Bowie (2C) participated in the Super 24 Mathematics Competition.
  - Seven S.3 students and three S.2 students participated in Pan-Asia Pacific International Mathematics Invitation Competition organized by Hong Kong Gifted

Education Association. Szeto Tak Hei (3B) and Yeung Sik Kwan (3B) won the Champion, Ngan Man Leon (3D) and Cheung Hei Yiu (2E) won First runner-up and Hui Chi Hin (3A), Huang Shiqi (3C), Leung Wing Sze (2D) and Lau Siu Yau (2B) won the Second runner-up.

- Kwok Ling Yan (4E) won the Merit in the Mathematics Invitation Competition organized by True Light Girls' College.

(7) Others

- (5) Sixty nine S.4 and S.5 Chemistry students were nominated to join the "Chemists Online Self-study Award Scheme" organized by the Hong Kong Virtual University.

- (7) Twenty S.3 students were nominated to join the "Web-based Learning Courses for Gifted and More Able Students" organized by the Hong Kong Academy for Gifted Education.

On 18<sup>th</sup> December, Mr. Lau CK attended a teacher's workshop on the "Wonder materials – Graphene and beyond" organized by the Hong Kong Science Museum.

(9) Others :

- On 1<sup>st</sup> December, a monthly newsletter of Science Society, "Sound of Science" was issued with the theme of "Industrial Use of Enzymes in our Daily Lives".

- (1) On 14<sup>th</sup> December, the annual Christmas Concert was successfully held. Programmes included choral singing, instrument ensembles and piano solo by guest performer Peggy Tang. About 200 students, including performers and the audience, attended this event to celebrate the festive joy with Christmas carols.
- (2) On 16<sup>th</sup> December, the senior *A cappella* group was invited to perform in the “18<sup>th</sup> Shenzhen Reading Month” essay writing competition prize presentation ceremony. They presented two songs “Another Say of Sun” and “The Rhythm of Life”.
- (3) On 17<sup>th</sup> December, the senior choir and the alumni choir jointly presented a “Carol Delight” at Mikiki Mall in San Po Kong. We celebrated the festive season and the love of Christmas with the audience through music for an hour.
- (4) To nurture life-long interest in performance arts appreciation, students were encouraged to attend concerts and performances organized by various organizations. Students were fully engaged and had enjoyable artistic experiences.
