1. The 45th Athletic Meet
On 1st and 2nd March, the 45th Athletic Meet was held at Hammer Hill Sports Ground. At the Opening Ceremony, I relayed to the students how an Athletic Meet was a way of learning. Ms. Ip Wan Fung, the Director (Track & Field) of Hong Kong Amateur Athletic Association, was invited to be our honorable guest to present prizes in the ceremony.

Mathematics Department

- (1) S.1-3 Mathematics tutorial classes were held for students in need every Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday in March. 61 S.1 -S.3 students were recruited.
