- (4) On 19th December, the Mathematics Olympiad Training Course was completed. Sixty-two S.1 –S.4 students joined the course with over 70% attendance rate. The participants will be selected to represent our school to join outside school competitions. Ms. Chu KM and Mr. Tai TT were the teachers in charge.
- (5) On 10th December, a RUMMIKUB competition was organized by the Mathematics Society.

One hundred and twelve students joined the activity.

- (6) The Mathematics Society organized an activity ‘Monthly Mathematics Challenge’ to arouse students’ interest in Mathematics. The winners for December were Ng Tung Yan (4A) and Chan Yee Lok (1C).
- (7) Participation in External Competition:
 - On 8th December, four S.1 and S.2 students participated in the 10th Super 24 Mathematics Competition.
 - On 16th December, sixteen S.2 to S.4 students participated in the Guangdong Big Bay Area Mathematics Competition 2019.
- (8) Results of External Competition:
 - Eight S.3 students and eight S.2 students participated in the Pan-Asia Pacific International Mathematics Invitation Competition organized by Hong Kong Gifted Education Association.
