1. Service Tour to Thailand North

From 14th to 18th February, the Life Education Committee organized a ‘Service Tour to Thailand North’. Sixteen students participated in the tour and it was led by Mr. Coleman Leung, Ms. Kwong Kit Sum Karrie, Ms. Chan Pui Ying Emely and Mr. Wong Kwok Wai. The aims of this tour were to provide opportunities for participating students to learn more about the living conditions in the northern part of Thailand and to gain an insight into how the church helps people in need. The participants had opportunities to serve the people with the local church.

2. Chinese New Year Concert

At lunch time on 22nd February, the Music Department organized a concert to celebrate Chinese New Year. Approximately 120 students and teachers attended the concert.

Mathematics Department

- (1) On 25th February, the Second Mathematics Department meeting was held. We discussed the following items:
 - Evaluation of the First Term results
 - Evaluation of the results of the HKDSE and the TSA examination.
 - Report of the implementation of learning support programmes for gifted students and low achievers
 - Report of the activities organized by the department
 - New textbooks for Extended Module (M2) of the Mathematics Curriculum.
- (2) S.1-3 Mathematics teachers discussed the arrangement of tutorial classes for junior forms students in need. Twenty S.1 students, eleven S.2 students and twenty S.3 students were recruited. The tutorial classes for S.1-3 will be held every Tuesday to Thursday in March.
- (3) Participation in Mathematics Competition outside school
 - a. On 23rd February, two S.2 and two S.1 students were nominated to participate in the Mathematics Creative Problem Solving Competition organized by Hong Kong Association for Science and Mathematics Education.
 - b. On 16th February, six S.4 students were nominated to participate in the Mathematics Competition organized by Education University of Hong Kong and the Education Bureau.
- (4) Our school exchanged our Mock Examination papers with Ying Wa Girls' School, Shatin Pui Ying College, CCC Ming Yin College, SKH Lam Kau Mow Secondary School and SKH Bishop Baker Secondary School to broaden our students' exposure to various styles of questions.
- (5) On 22nd February, a workshop was organized by Ms. Chu Ka Man for Mathematics Teachers. The topic was "How to use DESMOS platform in teaching" .

Chemistry Department (Science KLA)

- (1) Eighty-one S.5 students were nominated by Physics, Chemistry and Biology teachers to participate in the "Secondary School Mathematics and Science Competition" (SSMSC). This was organized by the Hong Kong Polytechnic University with the aids of Diversity Learning Grant.

- (2) Four S.3 and S.4 Chemistry students participated in the “Element of the Month for IYPT-2019 (February)” The competition was organized by the Hong Kong Association for Science and Mathematics Education. One student got a Merit Award.
