### **Mathematics Department**

- (1) S.1-3 Mathematics tutorial classes were held for students every Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday in March. Sixty one S.1 -S.3 students were recruited. Mr. Li WK, Ms. Lam YC, Ms. Chan ST, Mr. Lam HK, Mr. Tai TT, Mr. Moy KY and Mr. Yu YL and S.5 Maths Buddies were responsible for teaching the tutorial classes.
- (2) On 6<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> March after school, S.4 remedial classes were held. On 7<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> March after school, S.5 remedial classes were held. Mr. Li SF was responsible for both the S.4 and S.5 remedial classes and Mr. Lam HK, Mr. Li WK and the alumnus Au CH was the assistant for the classes.
- (3) In March, six S.4 students were nominated to participate in Mathematics \_An Octopus IV of the JSI workshop organized by the Faculty of Science of the University of Hong Kong.
- (4) Yung Wan Ching (1E) got the Second Class Prize. Chan Yuet Tung (1A), So Choi Ki (3D) got the Third Class Prize in the 11<sup>th</sup> “Hua Xia Cup” Chinese National Mathematics Olympic Hong Kong Selection.
