**1. Third Meeting of The School Administration Committee**

On 4th November, I chaired the third meeting of the School Administration Committee. Besides reviewing the activities in October, we discussed the following issues:

On 19<sup>th</sup> November, I chaired the Special Staff Meeting. We discussed the preparation for class resumption and the relevant support measures for students to face the challenges due to the social issues.

### **Mathematics Department**

- (1) One hundred and thirty-six students from fifteen primary schools in our district have registered the Joint Primary School Mathematics. However, the competition scheduled for 14th December has been cancelled due to the occurrence of the social issue.
- (2) The Mathematics Society organized an activity ‘Monthly Mathematics Challenge’ to arouse students’ interest in Mathematics. The winners for November were Chan Yau Ki (6D) and Wong Wing Yan (3A).
- (3) On 3rd November, six S.6 students participated in the Pan-Pacific Cup International Mathematics Competition (First Round) organized by Hong Kong Gifted Education Center. Mr. Li Wang Kin and Mr. Wong Chun Tat, the Vice-Principal were responsible for the competition.
- (4) After school On 5th November, a tutorial class of drilling Multiple Choice Questions for S.6 students was organized and delivered by Mr. Li Wang Kin and Mr. Wong Chun Tat, the Vice-Principal. Seventy S.6 students joined the class.
- (5) On 30th November, twenty S.6 students participated in the Mock Examination of Mathematics (Compulsory) organized by Hok Yau Club.
- (6) Professional Development :
  - On 26th November, Mr. Tai Tze Tik and Mr. Lam Ho Ka attended a seminar “Assessing Student Learning for the Secondary Mathematics Curriculum” organized by the Education Bureau.

- (3) S.6 students Chan Hiu Lung, Tang Ka Hei and Lai Ka Lok were awarded "Applied Learning Scholarship 2018/2019" organized by EDB and donated by Law's Charitable Foundation. Tang Ka Hei and Lai Ka Lok were even awarded "Special Appreciation" award.
