### **Mathematics Department**

- (1) The Mathematics Department has joined the EDB School Based Support Scheme. On 7 and 17 December, Curriculum Development Officer visited our school to attend meetings with our Mathematics teachers to discuss the design of lessons and evaluate the delivery of lessons. Mr. Li WK, Ms. Chu KM, Ms. Chan ST, Mr. Tai TT and Mr. Lam HK participated in the discussion.
- (2) The Mathematics Department jointly organized an activity Reading Report Competition with the Chinese Language Department and School Library to arouse students' interest in Mathematics. On 17 December, a briefing on the competition was organized. Mr. Li WK and Mr. Tai TT were the teachers in charge.
- (3) On 17 December, the Department organized a Pre-Mock Examination of Mathematics in Paper II (Multiple Choice) for S.6 students so as to provide them with more opportunities to be familiar with various questions types.
- (4) On 7 and 27 December, 118 S.6 students joined a Pre-Mock Examination of Mathematics organized by Canotta Publishing Company so as to provide them with more opportunities to be familiar with various questions types.

- (6) On 17 December, the Mathematics Olympiad Training Course was completed. Sixty-two S.1 –S.4 students joined the course with over 70% attendance rate. The participants will be selected to represent our school to join outside school competitions. Ms. Chu KM and Mr. Tai TT were the teachers in charge.
- (7) The Mathematics Society organized an activity Monthly Mathematics Challenge to arouse students' interest in Mathematics. The winners for December were Li Pak Ki (6D) and Chung Yiu Tung (1C).
- (8) Participation in External Competition:
  - On 15 December, fifteen S.2 to S.4 students participated in the Guangdong Big Bay Area Mathematics Competition 2020.

- (9) Results of External Competition:
- Four S.3 students and six S.2 students participated in the Pan-Asia Pacific International Mathematics Invitation Competition 2020 organized by Hong Kong Gifted Education Association. Lu Jia Luo (2C) got the First Class Merit, Zhou Yip Shing (3C), Tang Wang Chun (2E) and Cheung Tsz Chung (2D) got the Second Class Merit, Kwok Kin Lok (2B), Chung Ho Chak (2C), Fong Wing Yin (2D), Ng Cheuk Man (3C), Wong Cheung Yuen (3A) and Ng Man Wai (3C) got the Third Class Merit. S.2 students also won the Overall Second Runner-up in the First Round Competition.
- (10) At lunch time and after school on 11 December, the Mathematics Society organized Mathematics Carnival with mental arithmetic, using calculators and puzzles to boost students' interest in Mathematics.
