## 9. Report from Subject Departments

### **Mathematics Department (Mathematics KLA)**

- (1) The Mathematics Department has joined the EDB School Based Support Scheme. On 16th January, the Curriculum Development Officer visited our school to attend a meeting with our Mathematics teachers to discuss the design of lessons and evaluate the delivery of lessons. Mr. Li WK, Ms. Chu KM, Ms. Chan ST, Mr. Tai TT and Ms. Lam YC participated in the discussion.
- (2) The Mathematics Department co-organized with the School Library to create a Mathematics Reading Competition. The School Library has set up a Mathematics Reading Corner to collect a number of books about Mathematics. Mr. Li WK and Mr. Tai TT were in charge of this activity.
- (3) Students participated in the 13th Hua Xia Cup Mathematical Olympiad Invitation Competition. The results were as follows:
  - S.1: Four students got First Merits, three students got Second Merits, five students got Third Merits;
  - S.2: One student got a First Merit, one student got a Second Merit, two students got Third Merits;
  - S.3: One student got a First Merit, two students got Second Merits, three students got Third Merits.
- (4) Students participated in the 2020 Big Bay Area Mathematical Hong Kong Selection Competition. The results were as follows:
  - S.1: One student got a First Merit, one student got a Second Merit, one students got a Third Merit;
  - S.2: One student got a First Merit;
  - S.3: One student got a First Merit, one student got a Second Merit, 3 students got a Third Merit;
  - S.4 – S.6: One student got a First Merit, one student got a Second Merit.
- (5) On 11th January, 118 S.6 students joined a Pre-Mock Examination of Mathematics organized by Canotta Publishing Company so as to provide them with more

opportunities to be familiar with various questions types.

- (6) On 14 January, the Mathematics Society organized a “Rummikub” Competition to arouse students’ interest in learning Mathematics. Sixty-two students joined the competition. The winners of this competition will be invited to participate in the CCC Secondary Schools Rummikub Competition organized by the Association of Principals of CCC Secondary Schools.
- (7) On 15 January, a tutorial class for fifteen S.4 students were conducted by Mr. Lee S.F.
- (8) Professional Development Activities:

### **Chemistry Department (Science KLA)**
