1. New School Year Opening Ceremony

4. Student Leaders Inauguration Ceremony

5. The Second Staff Meeting cum the Cases Meeting

6. School Resumption

Owing to the relief of COVID-19, the Education Bureau (EDB) has announced a progressive class resumption. S.1, S.5 and S.6 students resumed classes on 23 September and S.2 to S.4 students resumed classes on 29 September. EDB also allowed schools to resume classes for S.6 students on 16 September. During the class suspension period, our school has thoroughly cleaned and disinfected the school campus. We will maintain the environmental hygiene of our school campus as best as we can to safeguard the health of our students. We hope that, after the class resumption, students can return to school and enjoy their learning in a safe environment. When students returned to school, I have given my warmest welcome to our students with a message and welcome gifts, including masks and some sanitizers.

7. Report from Subject Departments

Mathematics Department

- (1) The Mathematics Department nominated 5F student Li Kun Kei to join a lesson “Number Theory and Cryptography” 數論與密碼學 of the Elite Summer Course organized by the Chinese University of Hong Kong.
- (2) On 17 September, Mr. Li Wang Kin, the Mathematics Department Head, and Ms. Lam Yan Chi participated in the first Preparation Meeting for the “Hong Kong Primary School Mathematics Contest” discussing the workflow of the Contest and the contingency plan.
- (3) The Mathematics Department ordered a software MATHTYPE7 (with eight licenses), with a one-year subscription, to assist Mathematics teachers to edit Mathematics equations.
- (4) Professional Development
On 4 September, The Mathematics Department invited Pearson Publishing Company to deliver a workshop online. Mr. Li Wang Kin, the Mathematics Department Head, and Ms. Chu Ka Man, Mr. Tai Tze Tik, Ms. Lam Yan Chi, Mr. Lam Ho Ka and Ms. Tang So Kuen joined the workshop.

Chemistry Department (Science KLA)

- (1) Six gifted S.4 and S.5 science students were nominated to participate in the “Pilot Scheme for Secondary Schools – Dual Program” organized by the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology with the aid of “Diversity Learning Grant”.
- (2) Sixty-six S.5 and S.6 Chemistry students participated in the “Chemists Online Self-study Award Scheme (COSAS)” organized by the Hong Kong Virtual University. They got excellent results:

- (5) Eight S5 Chemistry students were divided into two teams and nominated to join the “Chinese Medicine Quiz Competition” organized by the Hong Kong Baptist University.
- (6) Two S5 Chemistry students were nominated to join the “Hong Kong Brain Bee Competition” organized by the Hong Kong Brain Foundation.
- (7) With the aids of the “Diversity Learning Grant”, twenty-eight S.6 Chemistry students were nominated to join the “HKDSE Chemistry Mock Examination” organized by the Hong Kong Association of Mathematics and Science Education.

Visual Arts Department
