8. Report from Subject Departments

Mathematics Department

(1) On 1 March, the Second Mathematics Department meeting was held. We discussed the following items:

- (2) The Mathematics Department has joined the EDUHK collaboration scheme. On 12 March, our colleagues discussed the design of tools to help our students access their learning progress and arouse their learning motivation. Mr. Li WK, Mr. Lam H.K, and Principal Dr. Chu K.W. participated in the discussion.
- (3) Three S.6 students who studied Mathematics Extended Module M2 joined a Pre-Mock Examination of Mathematics M2 organized by Canotta Publishing Company to provide them with more opportunities to be familiar with various question types.
- (4) The Mathematics Society organized an activity ‘Monthly Mathematics Challenge’ to arouse students’ interest in Mathematics. The winners for March were Lee Yiu Sing (2A) and Wong King Hang (5F).
