**3. Report from Subject Departments**

**Mathematics Department**

- (1) On 17 April, 5F Lai Tsz On, 5D Yeung Wing Yan and 3A Chung Ho Chak participated in The 38th Hong Kong Mathematics Olympiad jointly organized by the Mathematics Education Section of the Education Bureau and the Department of Mathematics and Information Technology of The Education University of Hong Kong. They have received

training on 22 March, 30 March, 12 April and 15 April. Ms. Chu KM was responsible for the competition.

- (2) Enhancement Classes of Mathematics Core were held on 13th, 20th, 22nd, 27th and 30th April for some S.6 students so as to help them better prepare for the HKDSE. Mr. Li WK and Mr. Tai TT conducted the tutorials.
- (3) On 22 April, an activity on Perpetual Calendar was organized by the Mathematics Society online. Fifty-two students joined the activity.
- (4) On 20 April, the Mathematics Society and The Core Group of Mathematics Teachers of CCC Secondary Schools co-organized an activity “Number Combination Game of 2022” to invite students to use various combination of 2,0,2,2 to form the set of digits from 1 to 100. The deadline of the activity is 10 May.
- (5) Professional Development Activities :
  - On 17 April, Mr. Li WK, Ms. Lam YC, Mr. Lam HK and Mr. Tai TT attended an online seminar in Mathematics “Mathematics Concept and Mentality in Mathematics Lessons” organized by the Core Group of Mathematics Teachers of CCC Secondary Schools.
  - On 20 April, Mr. Li WK attended an online seminar “Mathematics Education - Annual Sharing Series of the School-based Curriculum Development (Secondary) Section (2020/21)” organized by Education Bureau.

- (4) Twenty-four S.3 to S.5 students participated in the “HKUST Virtual Science Talks” organized by the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology.

- (6) A team of four S5 Chemistry students was nominated to join the “Hong Kong Student Forensic Science Competition” organized by the Hong Kong Sik Sik Yuen.
