On 22 May, 2020–2021 the Annual Speech Day was held. Professor Cheung shared his insights to encourage our students. He appreciated our students' performance, especially in their voluntary service to the community and gave us a lot of encouragement.

7. Report from Subject Departments

Mathematics Department

- (1) On 18 and 20 May, online tutorial classes were held for S.4 and S.5 students after school to assist them to prepare well for the coming examinations. Mr. Li WK and the student teachers from the CUHK were responsible for the classes.
- (2) On 14 May, The Mathematics Department organized a prize giving ceremony to recognize the students' achievements in some Mathematics competition outside school.
- (3) On 17 May, three students (2D Cheng Wing Yan, 5F Chu Chun Yin and Lee Koon Kei) represented our school to join the '2021 CCC Joint Schools Mathematics Competition' organized by the Association of Principals of CCC Secondary Schools. Mr. Li WK was responsible for training the students for the competition.
- (4) On 20 May, The Mathematics Department and the School Library jointly organized a book sharing of Mathematics books for students. Ninety-three students joined the sharing.
- (5) On 22 May, four students (1C Wong Yue Wai, 1E Li Tsz San, 2A Lee Yiu Sing and 2D Cheng Wing Yan) represented our school to join the 'Hong Kong Mathematics Creative Problem Solving Competition for Secondary Schools 2021' co-organised by the Education Bureau and Hong Kong Federation of Education Workers. The participating students received training on 15 and 17 May. Mr. Tai TT was responsible for training the students for the competition.
- (6) On 29 May, five students (4E Wong Chai, 4E Wong Wai Sum, 5D Leung Wing Sze, 5F Lai Tsz On and 5F Yang Wing Yan) represented our school to join the 'International Mathematical Olympiad Preliminary Selection Contest 2021' organised by the Hong Kong

Academy for Gifted Education. The participating students received training on 13 and 26 May. Ms. Chu KM was responsible for training the students for the competition.

(7) Professional Development Activities:

On 12 and 15 May, Mr. Li WK attended a markers' meeting for Mathematics papers of DSE 2021 organized by Hong Kong Examination and Assessment Authority (HKEAA).

(8) Others

From 17 to 25 May, Mathematics Department joined the School Experience Scheme for two student-teachers from the Chinese University of Hong Kong. The student-teachers had lesson observation, production of teaching material, teaching tutorial classes. The advisors for the student-teachers were Mr. Li WK, Mr. Tai TT and Mr. Lam HK.

Chemistry Department

- (1) Two S3 students participated in the “PolyU FAST Online Mini-Lecture Series (May)” organized by the Hong Kong Polytechnic University.
- (2) Six S5 students participated in the “ZOOM to Science” online lectures organized by the Chinese University of Hong Kong.
- (3) Eighty-three S3 to S5 Chemistry students were nominated to join the “2021 Australian National Chemistry Quiz (H.K. Section)” organized by the Royal Australian Chemical Institute.
- (4) With the aids of “Diversity Learning Grant”, one S5 gifted science student successfully completed the “Piloting Scheme for Secondary Schools – Dual Program (Level 2)” organized by the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology. They studied the “Introductory University level courses” on Chemistry. He got a B+ in his Level 2 examination.
