**June 2021**

1. School Administration Committee Meeting

On 9 June, I chaired the Meeting of the School Administration Committee. We discussed the School Organization Chart, classroom allocation and other school matters.

2. Second Term Examination

The Second Term Examination for S.3 to S.5 students was held from 9 to 25 June and the examination for S.1 to S.2 students was held from 11 to 25 June.

3. Fourth Department Heads Meeting

On 11 June, Ms. Tin Yuen Shan, the Vice-Principal, chaired the meeting. We discussed the evaluation of 2021 –2022 AAC Programme Plan and Departmental Programme Plan, quota for 2022 –2023 S.4 elective subjects and evaluation of routine items and other matters.

4. Visit from Dr. Kenneth Chan and the Participants of “School Improvement Programme” organized by the Hong Kong Institute of Education

On 17 June, Dr. Kenneth Chan and the participants of the “Professional Development Programme for Middle Leaders in Schools”, which was organized by the Hong Kong Institute of Education, visited our school. I introduced our school and management strategies. I also accompanied them on a campus tour.

5. Aerospace Science Talk

On the afternoon of June 25, Mr. Hu Hao, the Chief Designer of the third phase of the National Lunar Exploration Project, and a team of aerospace scientists visited our school to give a talk on the lunar exploration project for the CCC secondary schools. Our school was responsible for receiving guests and arranging for students from the seven CCC secondary schools to attend the face-to-face lectures. We also opened a YouTube Live broadcast channel and forwarded it to other teachers and students of the CCC secondary schools who did not have the opportunity to attend the talk so as to join the talk online. Mr. Hu introduced all aspects of the lunar exploration project in plain language, and patiently answered the enthusiastic questions from the students present. This lecture was a rare opportunity to acquire the latest knowledge of aerospace science and technology. Participating students have learned a lot from the lecture.

6. Reports from Subject Departments

**Mathematics Department**

- (1) On 16 June, the third department meeting was held. The following items were discussed:

- (3) S.2 student Lee Yiu Sing was nominated to the Hong Kong Academy for Gifted Education (HKAGE) Nomination Scheme 2020–2021 and he was successfully shortlisted to be admitted to the Gifted Education Programme offered by the HKAGE.
- (4) S.4 student Wong Chai participated in the International Mathematical Olympiad Preliminary Selection Contest — Hong Kong 2021 and was awarded Honourable Mention. Ms. Chu KM was responsible for his training.
- (5) Professional Activity: Mr. Li W.K. attended an online talk “2021 HKDSE Examination Mathematics Paper Analysis” organized by Pearson Hong Kong.

#### **Chemistry Department (Science KLA)**

- (1) Fifteen S5 Chemistry students were nominated to join the “Testing in Everyday Life” laboratory workshops organized by Hong Kong Baptist University.
- (2) With the aids of “Diversity Learning Grant”, four S4 gifted science student successfully completed the “Piloting Scheme for Secondary Schools – Dual Programme (Level 1)” organized by the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology. They earned two Bs and two Cs in their Level 1 examination.
- (3) Fifteen S1 to S5 students participated in the Organic Farming Training Programme organized by Hong Kong Baptist University.
- (4) One S5 students participated in the “Organic Farming Sticker Design Competition” organized by Hong Kong Baptist University. She won the Championship.
- (5) On 29 June, Eighty-three S3 to S5 Chemistry students participated in the “2021 Australian National Chemistry Quiz (H.K. Section)” organized by the Royal Australian Chemical Institute.
- (6) One group of four S5 Chemistry students were accepted to join the “Girls Go Tech Hackathon 2021” competition organized by the Hong Kong Women’s Foundation.
- (7) Professional Development Activity : On 1 June, Mr. Lau C.K. participated in the “Smart Cities Liveable Convenience with AI and Privacy Protection” workshop organized by Innovation and Technology Fund.

#### **Integrated Science Department**
